

## **Bledsoe's Anderson new TCC president**

Greg Anderson, manager of Bledsoe Telephone Cooperative in Pikeville, is the new president of the Tennessee Council of Cooperatives (TCC), which is celebrating its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year.

Anderson was elected at a meeting of the TCC board Feb. 24 in Nashville. He succeeds Jeff Griggs, director of education and training with Tennessee Farmers Cooperative in LaVergne.

Other 2007 officers elected were Charles Curtis, Tennessee Farm Bureau Federation, Columbia, vice president, adult programs; Joe Jackson, Tennessee Electric Cooperative Association, Nashville, vice president, education; Terry Mullican, Caney Fork Electric Cooperative, McMinnville, vice president, public relations; and Ricky West, Tazewell, Farm Credit Services of Mid-America, secretary-treasurer.

Anderson, Jackson and West were among directors re-elected to three-year terms on the board. The other was Amber DuMont of Maryland and Virginia Milk Producers in Reston, Va. Frank Jennings, president of Middle Tennessee Electric Membership Corporation in Murfreesboro, was elected to fill the unexpired term of Carl Brandt, general manager of Upper Cumberland Electric Membership Corporation in Carthage, who resigned.

TCC, organized in 1982, is made up of 93 cooperatives – electric, telephone, farm supply, dairy, financial, tobacco, artificial breeding and Tennessee Farm Bureau – that serve hundreds of thousands of Tennesseans.
